The minutes of the January 10, 2008 meeting were read and a correction was required for the Special Events and District 23 Website reports.

Financial Report - was provided by Corrine C. The first quarter balance sheet for District 23 was submitted with a balance of \$ 1,758. A new balance sheet format was approved and individual committee budgets were also approved. The NC General Service Committee Treasurer Report for 2008 was distributed with an individual group contribution breakdown.

Intergroup Report - was provided by Jim. Sales are up by 10% and group contributions are down by 12%.

Corrections Facilities Report - was provided by Dan B. There is a current balance of \$350 for Corrections and no additional funding is required. All of the meetings are well attended. Dan requested a volunteer to be named as an Administrative Assistant for his committee.

Treatment Facilities Report - was provided by Lou S. There is a current balance of \$350 for Treatment Facilities and no additional funding is required. Cone Behavior Health has 5 meetings a week at this time and would like to have 2 more. Cone also mentioned a meeting for the Adolescent Unit (ages 11 to 17). More research is required before a decision can be made. Dreams, Summit House and Bridgeway are still in the planning stage.

CPC/PI Report - was provided by Vickie. A \$300 budget was established for the committee for 2008. Airport Holiday Inn requested information for their employees and were pleased with the presentation. First Presbyterian Church Youth gave very positive feed back from their workshop. Greensboro College has also requested information.

Special Events Report - was provided by John T. A \$500 budget was established for 2008. Founders Day has been scheduled and the shelter deposit of \$125 has been donated.

Grapevine Report – was provided by MaryBryan. A \$200 budget was established for 2008. MaryBryan will begin using the computer at Intergroup as needed.

District 23 Website Report - was provided by Nancy H. The open item from the last meeting, copy right issues with AA Group Inventory on the District 23 website, was resolved. An email from World Services suggested we use a link to their site as opposed to duplicating the document on our site. It was suggested that www.nc23.org mailboxes be forwarded to the individual recipients.

DCM Report - was provided by Nancy H. A \$500 budget was established for 2008. The money will be used for conference expenses for the DCM and Alternate DCM.

Old Business – Formal budgets were established for all of the committees (see details in each committee report above). The District 23 LCM zone map was approved.

New Business - Two LCMs were elected for District 23. The LCMs are Yvonne and Jean. The district was divided into 4 zones. The zones, groups and coverage assignments are described in an attachment to these minutes.

The meeting was adjourned and the next meeting was scheduled for May 8, 2008; Westminster Presbyterian Church at 6:30 PM.
