Secretary's Report: Jean. Secretary's Report approved, with 2 corrections: The date for October was 12, not 1. The money saved by CPC/PI was \$60, not 460. These corrections will be made and forwarded to our Webmaster.

Treasurer's Report: Skip. Report was approved.

Committee Reports:

CFC: Tom. Meetings at the jail are going well. There are now 3-4 meetings a week on Monday and Wednesday. Volunteers are still needed. Tom distributed applications for approval to take meetings to the jail. He also reported that CFC is now working with NA to coordinate meetings and be more effective.

TFC: Jackie. Going well. For the benefit of the new chair she reported that the District now takes 64-67 meetings to treatment facilities, among which are Cone, Daymark, Salvation Army, Servant House. She said that Bridging the Gap had not been as promising. She said she had cards made up to give to persons coming out of Treatment which would give them a contact number while becoming established in AA.

CPC/PI: John. Libraries are restocked. He has made progress with the Nursing Program at UNCG and is going to speak to the students on Monday, November 13, from 3:00 to 3:50. In the beginning it was thought that 20 or so would

attend. At last count the number was 60 plus.

Special Events: Candy. Presented the bill for 3 months for the storage area. After a short discussion, it was decided that the District would pay for December, and then look into paying for one year which gives us one month free. Candy reported that she already has a committee working on the New Year's Eve Event. She said the budget for food, etc., is \$1,200. On top of that decorations are needed at a cost of approximately \$150-\$200. The total, including the storage unit, would be between \$1,800 and \$1,900.
