

# UNITY CLUB REOPENING

Effective Monday, June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020

While we do believe it is safe and necessary for groups to have the option to resume meeting at the club, we would also like to ensure every reasonable precaution is being taken. We are asking the following of all homegroups meeting at the Unity Club until further notice.

## Suggestions

- Encourage people who are exhibiting symptoms to not attend the meeting.
- Wash your hands before and after the meeting. Do not touch your face.
- If hand sanitizer is desired, we would ask each group to provide their own.
- Clean and sanitize the club before the meeting.
- Ask members to sit on the black vinyl chairs unless they require a chair with arms.
- Create a hybrid meeting with a Zoom component for those who still do not safe attending in person. (We are providing our Wi-Fi details for all attendees)
- Although we cannot make it a requirement to wear a mask, it is strongly encouraged.
- Encourage attendees to pay using a digital payment format.
- Do not hold hands at the close of the meeting for prayer.

## Requirements

- After the meeting each group must use disinfectant and paper towels to thoroughly clean the following.
  - Tables
  - Vinyl on Chairs
  - Chairs handles/arms
  - Doorknobs
  - Bathroom Faucets and Toilet Handles
  - Metal 7<sup>th</sup> Tradition bowl
  - Light Switches
- Do not re-arrange chairs, they are set up to enable safe social distancing.
- Do not pass 7<sup>th</sup> tradition baskets.
  - Instead, use the provided large metal bowl to collect 7<sup>th</sup> tradition contributions. Ask people to come to the bucket, please do not pass it around.
- For the time being it is BYOC (Bring Your Own Coffee)
- If you smoke on the back porch or in front of the building social distancing is required.
